# DONNA VANIER

## Humble Beginnings and Hard Work

“She was the hardest working person I’ve ever known, and always had a smile on her face,” said Mary Vanier about her mother Donna. “She was very much a person who wanted to get in and help, and when she said she’d do something, she did it 150%.”

Whether it was setting up for church or cleaning a bunk house at the family ranch, no job was beneath her. She did the labor herself, and it wasn’t unusual to find Donna on a riding mower well into her 70s. Much of her hard work ethic can be attributed to her upbringing.

Donna L. Vanier was born on October 24, 1934 in Salina, KS, and grew up in a working-class family with her younger brother Doug. Her father, Willis Lindsay, worked at KS Power and Light, living mostly paycheck to paycheck. Although her family didn’t have much extra in terms of money, she was very rich in her faith at Christ Cathedral Episcopal Church, and was a talented vocalist, singing and performing in many plays growing up.



After graduating from Salina High School, Donna attended the University of Kansas for two years before returning home to work at Dillons as a checker. Unbeknownst to Donna, her future mother-in-law, Lesta Vanier, had heard great things about this “young lady”, and made a point to go through Donna’s checkout line at Dillons to see if Donna might be a good match for her middle son John, “Jack” Vanier.

After that, the rest is history. Jack and Donna were married for 65 years and together, ran the family cattle business at C.K. Ranch west of Brookville while raising three children, Mary, Marty and John.

## Giving Back

Donna believed strongly in helping to provide opportunities for people, particularly children, to have a better life. Her son John says, “You can’t guarantee success, but you can guarantee opportunity,” and Jack and Donna very much lived by this. Donna grew up in a family that did not have a lot, so when she married into one that did, she took that with great responsibility and wanted to make a positive impact.

Her daughter Mary said, “She had this notion that in life, we’re all in this together, and we need to help each other whether we know each other or not. She wanted to lift people up and give them the opportunity to have the best life they can.” And that is what Donna did.



Donna was very active in the community during all stages of her life, whether it was with her children’s 4-H Club activities or serving on charitable boards in Salina. She had a huge soft spot for children and proudly served on the board of St. John’s Military School and was the driving force behind the Donna L. Vanier Children’s Center.

She contributed in ways that she felt she could help the most, whether it was through service, money or both. Recognition was not important to her; she gave back because she felt it was a calling from a greater power and that’s just “what you do.”

When Donna passed away on May 23, 2020, she left a gift in her will to the community foundation to create a permanent fund that will forever support the causes that were near and dear to her heart—human services, education, children and her church. As one of the Foundation’s founding donors and original board members, she knew that her gift would be well taken care of and distributed in the way that she wanted.

Donna loved people and she loved the people of Salina. It was home!

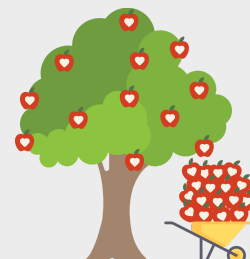

## Past, Present and Future Generations

The Koch family started H&B Communications in the 1930s with the hopes of providing the best service to their rural community. Years later, the family business has provided more than just telecom services. Rob Koch and his daughter Alison are committed to the same great service that Rob's grandparents provided, but also to serving and preserving the community.

Rob Koch, now retired, enjoyed the technical side of the business and putting his engineering background to use. He focused on trying to adapt new technologies by bringing them into the rural environment and having the community be the focus. Rob knows how lucky he and his family are to be a part of this business and he was motivated throughout his career to continue to build the legacy for the future of his family.

Alison is currently working at H&B Communications and is a 4th generation Koch family member. After earning her teaching degree, she found herself back in her hometown wondering what the next step in her career would be. As a teacher, Alison knew her role in life was to serve others. She quickly learned that by being a



part of this rural community in which she grew up, she was able to serve customers through their telecom needs as well as empower the community by giving back.

## Giving Quietly

The Koch Family started the H&B Communications Fund in hopes of helping the communities in which they serve see their value and continue to be sustainable. By choosing to open a fund with the Greater Salina Community Foundation, it allowed the Koch family to give back to charities for Christian education as well as a multitude of organizations in rural areas that need funding to get a project across the finish line.

"One cool part of using the foundation is having the check come from GSCF, that way they don't know it's from us", said Rob Koch. The privacy the foundation provides allows the Koch family to do exactly what they love, give help to people in need and keep the focus on those organizations. Through the Foundation the money has gone farther, gained efficiency, and provided them with the support they need.



## Servant Leadership

The answer to a simple question provided a great insight to the mission and values of the Koch family. When asked what they want to be remembered for, Rob answered: "I think it's okay if we're not. But if we are remembered, I'd like it to be for service, commitment, and helping others." Alison simply said, "What if the best outcomes are the ones that could be unknown?"

Overall, Rob and Alison enjoy seeing the projects from start to finish whether it is a new building in the community, a scholarship, or something that attracts family to the community. Through their fund at the Greater Salina Community Foundation, they have been able to provide help to people in need in a behind the scenes way, which is exactly what brings them joy.

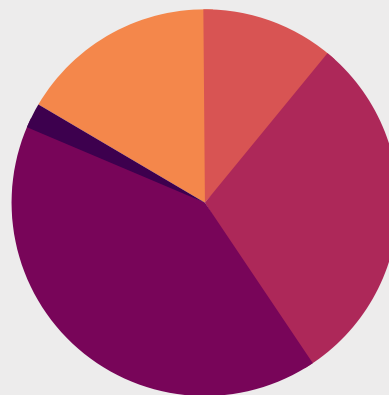

## A Passion for Painting

Marcella Dowling Oakes loved to paint, especially Kansas landscapes. A talented watercolor artist, she valued realism and drawing skills. Her son Dennis Oakes said she was very opinionated about this and had a disdain for abstract art, or as she would say “paint thrown from a bucket.” During her lifetime she sold over 900 paintings, however, it was her family and raising three boys that meant the world to her.

Marcella was born and raised in Salina, graduating from Sacred Heart High School in 1939 before moving to Chicago in 1942 to study at the Art Institute of Chicago. While in school, she corresponded overseas with a young military man from Chicago serving in World War II named William Robert Oakes. When the war was over, the two hit it off in person and were married for 23 years.

After her husband passed away, Marcella moved back to Salina to be near her family. She worked as a bookkeeper for Ballou Construction, while painting on the side. She displayed and sold her artwork throughout the region, including a couple of Smoky Hill River Festival shows.

Her son Dennis remembers taking Marcella and her sister Anna Eitel (also an artist) on country drives around Salina so they could gather “material” for their paintings.

Dennis said, “I’d be driving down some godforsaken road that looked

like it was going to end any minute, and they would yell, ‘Stop, Stop!’ and then they’d jump out, take the shot and then paint it when they got home.”

## Creating A Legacy

When Marcella passed away in 2007, her son Dennis wanted to do something to always remember his mother. With the money from his inheritance, Dennis and his wife, Martha, decided to establish a scholarship fund in her name to benefit Saline County students with a talent in drawing who wanted to pursue a degree in an art field.

“Salina was her home, and I wanted her name to be remembered. For however long the Greater Salina Community Foundation exists, her name will be remembered,” said Dennis. “She was always doing something for someone else, and this was something we could do for her.” Constantly worrying about her boys, Dennis joked that one of them was always “in the box,” or hot seat. She remained this way up until the day she died, saying one last time, “Now you boys be good.”

## Providing Opportunities

Dennis was also inspired to use this fund to provide opportunities for students who may not have the financial means to further their education. Growing up on the south side of Chicago, his parents did not have the money to send him or his brothers to school. If it were not for the two small scholarships he

received for tuition and bus fare to the University of Illinois at Chicago, he would not have gone.

“Those two scholarships, although they were small, gave me the motivation to go ahead and go. Maybe there are other kids in the same boat, and this scholarship would give them a similar head start,” said Dennis.

Since establishing the fund, Dennis and Martha have been able to see the impact firsthand by serving on the selection committee and meeting the recipients. In fact, 2020 recipient, Madeline Paradis attended Columbia College Chicago for graphic design, just half a mile from the Art Institute of Chicago where Marcella started her career, bringing this full circle.

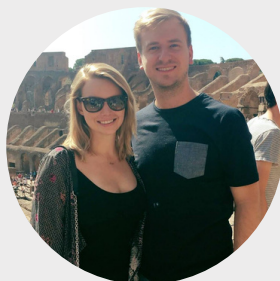
This was their first year to give through Match Madness and they saw it as a "way to help the Symphony have long-term impact."

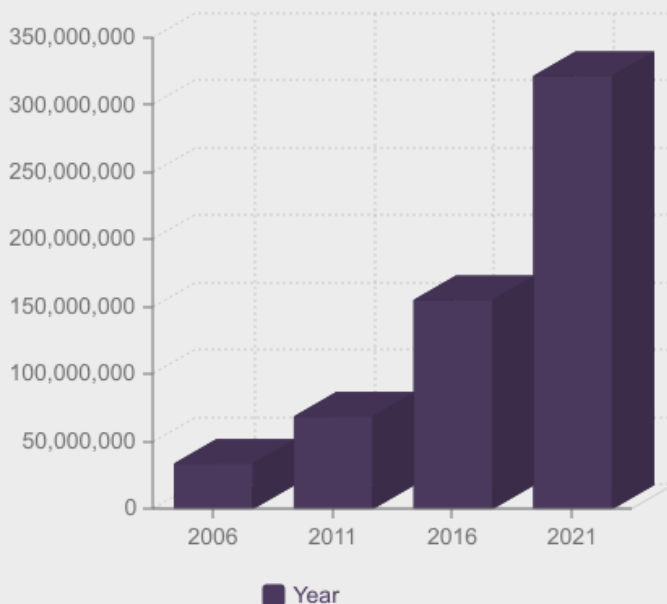

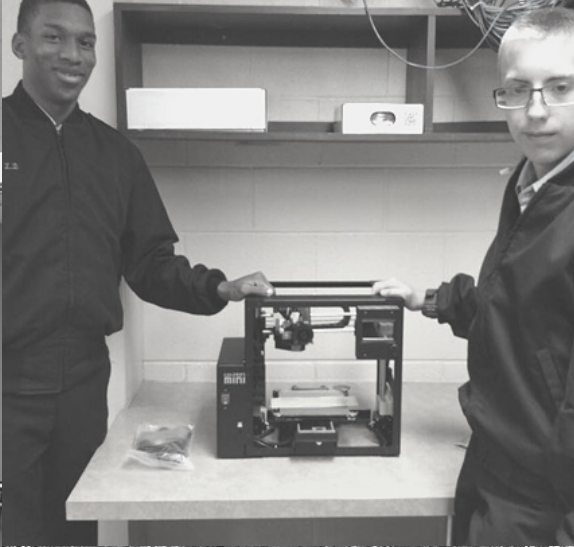
